In the Dominican Republic

Located in the Island of Hispaniola in the heart of Caribbean, the Dominican Republic is surrounded by the Atlantic Ocean to the north and to the south by the Caribbean Sea and enjoys a tropical climate year-round. It is in the second largest nation in the Caribbean by area and population with nearly 10 million people. The capital of the Dominican Republic is Santo Domingo, which is the oldest city in the new world. It has a population of almost 1 million people (as 2010). The official language is Spanish and the island is shared with Haiti.

Known for our warm and hospitable people, the Dominican Republic features astounding nature, intriguing history and rich culture. A geographically diverse nation, the Dominican Republic is home to the region's tallest mountain peak, Pico Duarte, as well as the Caribbean's largest lake and lowest elevation, Lake Enriquillo. The country is also the site of the first cathedral, the castle, monastery, and fortress built in all of the Americas, located in Santo Domingo's Colonial Zone, an area declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.
